- Meeting was called to order at 5:32pm by Lori Stuart.
- Pledge of Allegiance was led by Monarch students modeling Monarch Spirit Wear
- PTA memberships as of 9/9 were at 641 or 68%. To reach 100% we need 940. Class awards will go to those classes that get 100%
